

ORDINANCE NO. 11-14

PASSED: March 24, 2014

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR CMOM PROGRAM, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with EMH&T, 5500 New Albany Road, Columbus, OH, 43054 for preliminary engineering, prepare bid documents, estimates of construction cost, and supply bid documents for distribution, advertise for bids received and preparation of bid tabs, and final engineering for the CMOM Program.

SECTION 2. That to fund advertisement for the program referred to in Section 1, an amount of \$22,468.00 in the unappropriated Sewer CIP Account 720.000.000.5622 shall be and is hereby appropriated to account number 720.000.141.5622 to cover the cost of preliminary engineering, final engineering and bidding services.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City, and further for the reason that the project should begin as quickly as possible so it may be finished this year; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
