

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH KUSTOM SIGNAL, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF NEW CAMERAS FOR MARKED VEHICLES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Kustom Signal, Inc., 9652 Loriet, Lenexa, KS, 66219 in the amount of \$90,000 for the purchase of new cameras for marked vehicles, which allows for a 6% contingency.


SECTION 2. That to fund the purchase referred to in Section 1, an amount of \$90,000 in the unappropriated Federal Forfeiture Fund (294) be and is hereby appropriated to account no. 294.111.5529.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to CRC Section 8.04( c) competitive bidding is hereby suspended.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city and further so monies will be available to obtain the new cameras; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
