

ORDINANCE NO. 18-14

PASSED: April 14, 2014

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CITY AUDITOR TO ESTABLISH THE "Indigent Drivers Interlock and Alcohol Monitoring Fund" AS REQUIRED BY ORC 4511.191 (I) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to establish the "Indigent Drivers Interlock and Alcohol Monitoring Fund" (Fund No. 299), as required by ORC 4511.191 (I).

SECTION 2. That the monies received and appropriated to account no. 299.111.5529 shall be used for court ordered alcohol monitoring.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure for the financial needs of the city, and further so a fund will be in place in which to deposit monies that have been received; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
