

ORDINANCE NO. 48-14

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR THE 2014 LUCKS ROAD WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with Kendrick Excavating, Inc., 3725 New Riley Road, Dresden, Ohio, 43821 in the amount of \$449,800.00, for the 2014 Lucks Road Waterline Replacement Project, the project costs to be as follows:

Contract amount.....	\$ 449,800.00
Contingency.....	<u>\$44,980.00</u>
Total.....	\$ 494,780.00

SECTION 2. That to fund the project referred to in Section 1, an amount of \$494,780.00 in the unappropriated Water CIP Fund shall be and is hereby appropriated to account number 710.000.0140.5621.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety and further for the reason that the project should begin as quickly as possible; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
