

ORDINANCE NO. 56-14

PASSED: July 28, 2014

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED CIP FUND (410) FOR SENIOR CENTER PARKING LOT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That an amount of \$80,000 in the unappropriated Capital Improvements Program Fund (410) be and is hereby appropriated to account no. 410.000.139.5602. This amount represents an advance from the Capital Improvements Program Fund and an allowable portion will be reimbursed to the Capital Improvements Program Fund from EPA grant funds.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city and further in order to allow the project to move forward and be done timely; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
