

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CITY AUDITOR TO REMOVE EQUIPMENT FROM THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET LIST AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City Auditor be and is hereby authorized and directed to remove the following items from the city's Fixed Asset list:

from the Reynoldsburg Street Department:


- Asset #1769 Monroe Tailgate Salt Spreader

SECTION 2. That the Reynoldsburg Street Department and Mechanic have disposed of the items referred to in Section 1 and any proceeds from the items will be used for trade in or deposited into the appropriate fund.


