

ORDINANCE NO. 99-14

PASSED: December 15, 2014

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR CITY INSURANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract for city insurance for a one year period beginning January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015 with Willis of Ohio, Inc. and its related companies in the amount not to exceed \$153,000.00.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to CRC Section 8.04 (c), competitive bidding for said insurance is hereby suspended.


