ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO: AMENDING SECTION 913.04 SPECIFICATIONS, PERMIT FEE OF CHAPTER 913 PRIVATE ROADWAYS; AND SECTION 1127.09 UNDERGROUND ELECTRIC AND TELEPHONE LINES OF CHAPTER 1127 STANDARDS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Section 913.04 Specifications, Permit Fee of Chapter 913 Private Roadways and Section 1127.09 Underground Electric and Telephone Lines of Chapter 1127 Standards of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Reynoldsburg be and are hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. That existing Section 913.04 of Chapter 913 and Section 1127.09 of Chapter 1127 be and is hereby repealed and replaced.

SECTION 5. That upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect thirty days following signature by the Mayor.

(b) The minimum pavement width for private roadways shall be twenty-six feet and the maximum grade shall be six percent, provided that the minimum grade for private roadways shall be one-half of one percent at the gutter, unless otherwise approved by the ~~Director of Engineering~~ City Engineer.

## 1127.09 UNDERGROUND ELECTRIC AND TELEPHONE LINES.

(c) The preliminary plan with respect to the subdivision shall be submitted to the ~~Director of Engineering~~ City Engineer and to the electric and telephone utility companies which will provide service to the subdivision for their recommendations with respect to the width and location of easements for electric and telephone distribution cables and related facilities. The recommendations of the City Engineer and such utility companies shall be submitted to the Planning Commission by the owner of the subdivision together with the plat of the subdivision. Prior to signing the plat of the subdivision, the Planning Commission shall determine that adequate easements are provided for all utility services, including underground electric and telephone distribution wires, conduits, cables, gas pipelines, sewer and water lines. The owner of the subdivision shall, at the time the plat of the subdivision is submitted for approval, present such evidence as the Planning Commission deems necessary to ensure that the owner shall make or has made provision for all utility services, including underground electric and telephone distribution wires, conduits, cables, gas pipelines, sewer and water lines in accordance with this section, adequate for the anticipated needs of the subdivision.
