
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with ~~Watertronics, a Lindsay Corporation, 525 E. Industrial Drive, Hartland, WI, 53029~~ **ProPump & Controls Inc, 6810 Enterprise Drive, Delta, Ohio 43515** in the amount of \$26,355.00 for the purchase of the pumping system.

SECTION 2. That an amount of \$26,355.00 in the unappropriated General Fund be and is hereby appropriated to Account 110.448.5367 "Service Department- Streetscape Maintenance"

SECTION 3. That pursuant to CRC Section 8.04(c) competitive bidding is hereby suspended.




