From the Desk of the Director

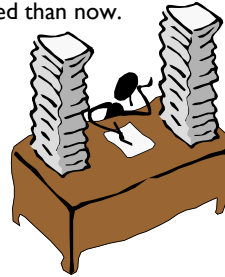
