Permit Parking

What You Need To Know

Residents must sign for all Parking Permits.

(Permits are non-transferable)

Do I have to pay for the permits?

NO The City is providing the permits at no cost to the residents.

How many permits will I receive?

Each household may receive up to four (4) Resident parking permits (red) and two (2) Visitor permits (blue).

Where do I place the permit on my vehicle?

The permit should be placed on the windshield side of the rear view mirror; allowing the number to be visible from the front of the vehicle.

Must the permit be displayed at all times?

NO The permits are only required on **SCHOOL DAYS**, between the hours of 7:00 AM and 2:00 PM. It may be easier to just hang the tag and leave on the mirror so you don't forget to put it there during the restricted hours.

What do I do if I lose or misplace a permit?

If a replacement is necessary:

You must pick up your permits (since a signature is required) at the Receptionist desk at the Reynoldsburg Municipal Building (first floor), 7232 E. Main Street between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday thru Friday (except holidays).

Who is exempt from using a parking permit?

Delivery trucks, utility companies (phone, gas, electric, cable, etc.), City owned vehicles and any vehicles belonging to companies providing services for the residents.

How do I report illegal parking?
