



6 Things to Remember

Your community is policed by the Reynoldsburg Division of Police. You can help your police department do a better job protecting you and your property if you will follow these six suggestions:

1. Complete the reverse side of this pamphlet & keep it in a safe place. The information listed is invaluable in tracing lost or stolen articles. Without identification, property cannot be used as evidence, cannot be traced & returned to you or may be returned to the thief on demand.
2. Do promptly notify your police department of any unusual or suspicious person, vehicle or activity in your vicinity.
3. Do promptly report any loss, theft or damage of your property to your police department.
4. Do keep your garage doors closed and your property stored as securely as possible. Articles that are plainly visible or lying unattended are an open invitation to thieves and vandals.
5. Do keep a light on in your home at night! Darkness invites crime.....light discourages crime.
6. Don't leave your residence for long periods of time unless you arrange for mail pick-up and discontinue deliveries.

Protect Your Home



Burglary is a problem, but to avoid it happening to you, something can be done!

Whenever you leave your residence to spend an evening at the movies, or take off for a weekend of fun in the sun, housebreakers can and will move in if they are certain you've left. Burglars spend their daylight hours canvassing neighborhoods looking for overstuffed mailboxes and uncut lawns. They spend spare evenings looking for darkened houses—or lights that are left on too long. You can help your police department reduce burglaries in your community by following the suggestions in this pamphlet.
